Chamber's Note Festa della Repubblica

On the 2nd of June, 1946, Italy decided to become a Republic by means of an institutional referendum. After more than eighty years the Savoy family's reign (which also included the Fascist period) ended. On the 2nd and 3rd of June 1946, 13 million women voted for the first time alongside 12 million men and 54% of the votes went in favour of the Republic. Moreover, there was a vote for the Constituent Assembly, the body that undertook the drafting of the new Constitution, which came into force on the 1st of January 1948. Since then, every year the Italian people and its institutions celebrate Republic Day.

The term "republic" derives from the Latin res publica, "public thing, of everyone", and indicates a form of government that is opposed to monarchy. There are different types of republics; Italy (as stated in Article 1 of its Constitution) is a democratic republic where power is exercised by all citizens through their representatives in Parliament elected by universal suffrage. Furthermore, Italy is a parliamentary republic, since it is the Parliament that has a central role and elects the Head of State, i.e. the President of the Republic (a position distinct from that of Head of Government).

The Palazzo del Quirinale, originally the residence of the King of Italy, has been the official residence of the Head of State since the birth of the Italian Republic. The Palace was built on the hill of the same name in Rome; its name derives from that of the Roman god Quirino, whose temple once stood on this hill.

The Unknown Soldier is an Italian soldier who fell during the First World War. Buried at the Altare della Patria in the early 1920s, it has become the symbol of all the fallen and all those missing in war.

The Altare della Patria is part of the Vittoriano architectural complex, a monument dedicated to Vittorio Emanuele II of Savoy, the first king of Italy, and to the Risorgimento, i.e. that historical period which led to the unification of Italy in 1861.

In collaboration with the Romaeuropa Foundation, the competition-prize focuses on original works of contemporary creation developed in the disciplines of theatre, dance and music.

The fifth edition of "Vivo d'Arte" is underway, the competition-prize promoted by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation in collaboration with the Romaeuropa Foundation dedicated to young Italian artists, under 36 years of age and permanently resident abroad.

The object of the competition-prize is original works of contemporary creation developed in the disciplines of theatre, dance and music, which develop the theme of contamination - encounter with the culture of the country of residence and foresee the possible involvement of local artists.

The winning project will be represented in the national première in the next edition of the Romaeuropa Festival, which will be held in Rome from 6 September to 19 November 2023. The expenses related to the creation and production of the winning show, the cachet and the hospitality, within the limits is indicated in the Regulations.

The deadline for receiving applications is 11.59 pm (Italian time) on 18 June 2023. The methods for sending applications are indicated in the Regulations available in the attachment.
